

Federal Pell Grant Calculations

The amount of your Federal Pell Grant award has been calculated from the information reported on your Student Aid Report (SAR) and is **based upon your enrollment in 12 or more eligible units each semester**. Federal Pell Grant regulations require enrollment in an eligible program leading to a degree, certificate, or transfer requirements.

Award amounts are for the academic year, and you will receive $\frac{1}{2}$ of the award in fall, and $\frac{1}{2}$ of the award in the spring.

**THE 1st FALL PAYMENT WILL BE ISSUED BEGINNING
FRIDAY, AUGUST 18th**

and will be calculated based upon your enrollment as of **August 11, 2017**.

**THE 1st SPRING PAYMENT WILL BE ISSUED BEGINNING
FRIDAY, JANUARY 12th**

and will be calculated based upon your enrollment as of **January 4, 2018**.

There are 3 (three) disbursements each semester.

First payment is 30% of your award

Second payment is 20% of your award

Third payment is 50% of your award

All payments will be adjusted based upon your enrollment status at the time each payment is processed, approximately 7 days prior to the disbursement date. **However, if you drop units at any time during the semester, you may not be eligible to receive further payment and/or you may owe all or a portion of your first payment to the institution and/or the U.S. Department of Education.**

You can determine adjustments to your semester award by using the calculation below.

NOTE: Enrollment status includes only eligible units as outlined in the Terms of Agreement /Satisfactory Academic Progress Regulations.

12 or more	Full-time	No Adjustment
9 – 11.5	Three Quarter-time	Semester Award x .75
6 – 8.5	Half-time	Semester Award x .50
